

**MINUTES OF WAYNE TOWNSHIP  
MEETING OF JULY 12, 2018**

The Board of Supervisors regularly scheduled meeting was called to order at 7:05 p.m. on July 12, 2018. Supervisors present were Glenn Miller, Chairman, James Long, Jr., and Jay Romig. Also present were Engineer, Ed Fisher and Solicitor, Linus Fenicle. EMC Coordinator, Don Shutt, was present as was Eli Shoop, Road Foreman. James Long, Sr., Betty Reigle, and Jason Faust were also present at the meeting.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and the Board took roll call. The minutes of the June 14, 2018 Board of Supervisors meeting were approved by motion of Jay Romig, and seconded by James Long, Jr., with all Supervisors voting in favor. The bid opening for sealcoat on Dividing Ridge Road was conducted and there was only one bid received from Hammaker East in the amount of \$31,850. After discussion by the Board, it was decided to reject all bids in view of the higher than expected amount and do the project next year. The motion to reject all bids was made by James Long, Jr., seconded by Jay Romig, with all Supervisors voting in favor. A motion was made to pay all interim and unpaid bills by James Long, Jr., seconded by Glenn Miller, with all Supervisors voting in favor.

Eli Shoop presented the road report. Eli Shoop was directed to secure names of individuals to serve as road workers and submit the names to the Board of Supervisors. EMC Coordinator, Don Shutt, had no report.

The ordinance establishing a volunteer tax credit for members of the Volunteer Fire Company serving the Township, was adopted by motion made by Glenn Miller, seconded by Jay Romig, with all Supervisors voting in favor. The resolution mentioned in said ordinance to establish the volunteer criteria to qualify for the tax credit was

approved by the Board of Supervisors, with Jay Romig making the motion, seconded by James Long, Jr., with all Supervisors voting in favor.

There was discussion by the Board of Supervisors in regard to certain bills for stones and delivery. There was also discussion by the Board in regard to Timber Falls Drive and a drainage issue on Timber Falls Drive. There was also discussion of the Pheasant Hill subdivision and the need for the deed of dedication. There was mention made of Conrad Vaughn cutting trees and shrubs on his property and depositing on the Township right-of-way.

Visitor, Betty Reigle, raised some concerns about weeds on the roadway at Sheetz and Powells Valley Roads and also some other matters that she had concerns about.

The Board discussed that trimming needs to be done, especially trimming of shrubbery on Dividing Ridge Road and a chipper needs to be rented.

A motion was made by Glenn Miller to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Jay Romig, with all Supervisors voting in favor, said adjournment occurring at 8:23 p.m.
