ENGINEER REPORT

Ed Fisher stated that the Back Road Leveling course will be started the first week of August. The asphalt index has increased \$4.00 or more a ton. This will increase the cost \$12,000.00 or more.

405 Small Valley Road – Stormwater issues, no permits issued but hole is dug which is 5' to 8' to close to the right-of-way.
