EMC REPORT

Don reported that there is a new policy to building code for Bi-Directional Amplifier systems. The new policy does not apply to one or two family residential home, it more applies to commercial/industrial buildings. The policy also states that any remodeling and/or new additions to existing buildings will require a review. Also, emergency personnel would need to do a radio communications review of the build and/or new additions. It, also includes a five year inspection of the facilities by emergency personnel to ensure the system is still functional.

He also reported that we should consider a radio base station and one portable hand set at the Community Building for disasters. This should be inspected every 5 years.
